

NCI Report: Supplemental Report: Talking Points

Based on the *National Citizens Inquiry Supplemental Report – Regina* (November 28, 2024) and relevant hearing transcripts, here are 25 carefully selected and thematically grouped talking points:

I. Governance, Accountability & Oversight

1. **Lack of Government Participation:** Despite invitations, no federal or provincial agencies participated in the Regina hearings.
2. **Erosion of Democratic Processes:** Emergency measures frequently bypassed legislative scrutiny, undermining democratic norms.
3. **Failures of Regulatory Bodies:** Multiple professional regulatory bodies acted against their mandates by suppressing dissent and failing to protect the public.
4. **Police Conduct Concerns:** Police services were criticized for enforcing health mandates disproportionately and without adequate oversight.
5. **Call for Independent Oversight:** Witnesses and commissioners emphasized the need for impartial bodies to monitor public health policy responses and regulatory conduct.

II. Health & Medical Practices

6. **Vaccine Approval Shortcomings:** Concerns were raised about insufficient clinical trial data for vaccines ultimately distributed to the public.
7. **DNA Contamination in Vaccines:** Expert testimony revealed findings of residual plasmid DNA and SV40 sequences in mRNA vaccines.
8. **Inadequate Adverse Event Reporting:** The health system was criticized for downplaying or failing to track vaccine injury reports effectively.
9. **Suppression of Early Treatment Options:** Evidence was presented indicating a coordinated effort to suppress repurposed drugs like ivermectin.
10. **Censorship of Medical Experts:** Health professionals offering contrary opinions faced de-platforming, loss of licensure, or professional sanctions.

III. Ethical and Legal Concerns

11. **Informed Consent Violations:** Many vaccine recipients were not provided with adequate information to make informed choices.
12. **Medical Coercion:** Testimonies described instances of coercion in employment, education, and healthcare settings regarding vaccination.
13. **Loss of Public Trust:** Public confidence in health institutions has significantly eroded due to perceived conflicts of interest and inconsistent messaging.
14. **Financial Conflicts in Science & Regulation:** Witnesses highlighted pharmaceutical influence over peer review and public health decisions.
15. **Unaddressed Vaccine Injuries:** Numerous individuals testified about serious injuries that were dismissed or left untreated by the medical system.

IV. Social and Economic Impact

16. **Neglect of Seniors:** COVID-19 measures led to harmful isolation of elderly populations in care facilities, contributing to preventable deaths.
17. **Mental Health Decline:** Prolonged fear-based messaging, isolation, and social disruption have exacerbated psychological distress, particularly among youth.
18. **Propaganda and Fear Campaigns:** Government and media messaging were described as deliberately inducing fear to compel compliance.
19. **Economic Devastation:** Small businesses, especially in hospitality and services, suffered disproportionate losses under lockdown policies.
20. **Financial and Bureaucratic Inequities:** Relief programs were inconsistently applied and favoured larger corporations over small businesses.

V. Recommendations and Future Directions

- 21. Transparent Scientific Debate:** Witnesses called for open forums to debate evidence and policy without censorship or reprisal.
- 22. Restoration of Ethical Standards:** A return to basic ethical principles in medicine and governance was repeatedly emphasized.
- 23. Establishment of Independent Media:** The report supports developing alternative media platforms to counter biased or incomplete coverage.
- 24. Redress for Victims:** Recommendations include compensation for those harmed by COVID-19 policies or vaccine injuries.
- 25. Ongoing Citizen Inquiries:** The NCI encourages continued public engagement and investigations to prevent repetition of systemic failures.
