Ken's mind is a battlefield of research, strategy, and storytelling — dissecting government structures one day, then crafting a dystopian storyboard or a patriotic piano video the next. He has over 40 years of experience as a Professional Engineer, which includes 29 years experience in the development and management of national and regional engineering businesses.

Ken is the Chairman of the Independent Commissioners at the National Citizens Inquiry and co-author of the 5,342 page investigative report, "Inquiry into the Appropriateness and Efficacy of the COVID-19 Response in Canada".

He is the founder of Citizens for Truth and the author of the 89 page investigative report "Investigation into Criminal Allegations Concerning COVID-19 Pandemic Response".

He is co-founder of Manitoba Stronger Together which is a grassroots, non-partisan citizens group seeking to restore democratic power to the people of Manitoba.

Experience in the engineering consulting industry includes 11 years as National Director of Industrial / Commercial Engineering for UMA Engineering Ltd. and 18 years as Founder, President & CEO of Accutech Engineering Inc.

After having established Accutech as a leader in the development of Arctic projects, in 2015 he successfully negotiated the sale of Accutech Engineering Inc., to a group of investors.

Accutech remains the most recognized name in Arctic development in Canada, and annually completes the design for some \$50 M dollars of construction in Canada's Arctic.

Following the sale of Accutech Engineering Inc., he established Artisanal Steel, a specially steel fabrication company, and Studio Bella Rosa, an Audio and Video production company.

Ken remains active in the engineering consulting business providing services related to design, forensic investigations and the development of industry standards and regulator processes.

Ken's business experience includes overall responsibility for multi-disciplinary engineering groups, within a nation wide firm, to the start-up, growth, operation and sustaining of a multi-disciplinary engineering company.

His experience as an engineer includes structural design, project management, functional programming, planning, management and contract administration of a wide variety of projects.

Major engineering projects completed are located across North America, from the North Shore of Baffin Island to the West Coast of California. Major international work has included projects in the Nile Valley, Egypt, and a major energy production project in Austria.

He has been involved with new product development, building design, industrial process improvement, forensic investigations, expert witness, and many other areas of engineering design and development.

Ken is a recognized expert in the area of Arctic Development including design of buildings on permafrost.

He is the inventor of two proprietary engineering systems including:
